Special Note: Students must bring a scientific calculator to the course, preferably a **TI-30X IIS** or equivalent. Specific functions required include: standard deviation, permutations and combinations, factorial, log, correlation coefficient, and trigonometry.

Course Description:

This three-day course is designed to prepare individuals for the Comprehensive Examination leading to certification as a CSP. The course covers all three areas of the exam. The course consists of lectures, sample problems, and discussions on a variety of subjects to prepare the student for the exam. Pertinent reference materials are also discussed to allow students to focus their studies in specific areas prior to sitting for the exam. In particular, this course will:

- * provide an outline for study for those beginning their preparation
- * "fine tune" participants who have been preparing for the exam
- * review details and current blueprints of the test subjects
- * provide practice problems for class plus outside "opportunities"
- * review current suggested readings and other study aids
- * identify areas where participants need additional study
